



Grill – Casual attire is permitted including golf shoes, golf and tennis attire and denim. Swimsuits are not permitted without a cover-up. Bare feet and stocking feet are not permitted anywhere in the Clubhouse. Men may not wear tank tops or sleeveless shirts.

Swimming Pool – Proper swimwear is required. We are a family club. Bathing suits are not to be worn in the Clubhouse.

Tennis – Proper tennis attire and non-marking tennis shoes are required when playing or practicing. No denim permitted regardless of color.

Fitness Center – Proper fitness attire and athletic shoes are required. No swimsuits, denim or bare feet permitted. Sleeveless shirts may not be tattered, torn, or cut.

Hats and Caps Policy – Hats may only be worn indoors within the confines of the Pro Shops, locker rooms and grill. Hats must be worn with the bill facing forward. Dressy hats, religious or health related head coverings will be allowed for appropriate occasions.



Children's Code of Conduct—Children under the age of 18 are permitted access to the Clubhouse with the understanding that they conduct themselves as ladies and gentlemen. They are not allowed to loiter, romp or play in the Clubhouse. Parents or other adults bringing young children into the Clubhouse must keep them in their immediate presence and under their control.

Smoking Policy—Crow Canyon Country Club permits smoking in designated outside areas. Members and guests may smoke in the parking areas of the Club, on the Golf Course during play (subject to acceptance to all other in the group) and on the Upper Ballroom Terrace. All other outside areas are non-smoking areas. Smoking is not permitted inside any structure on the property.

Dress Attire & Code of Conduct

Clubhouse (Country Club Attire) – The Club's dress attire is designed to provide direction and to alleviate confusion among our members and guests with regards to what dress is appropriate and to allow everyone to experience a high level of enjoyment while visiting the club.

Members are responsible for ensuring their guests know proper dress attire before arriving at the Club. Our staff is available to answer any question members may have regarding the dress code. Staff has also been directed to courteously remind any member or guest not compliant of the standards.



GOLF COURSE

Golf attire is required while playing or practicing. No denim permitted regardless of color.

1. Women, Girls & Juniors – No denim or t-shirts. Slacks, Bermuda shorts, capris, & skirts permitted. Collared shirt, sleeveless blouses, turtle neck or mock necks permitted. Hats & visors must be worn in a forward position. No halter or crop tops.
2. Men, Boys, Juniors – No denim or t-shirts. Slacks, Bermuda shorts, and cargos are permitted. Shirts must have a collar and sleeves. Shirts must be tucked in.
3. **Shoes** – Soft spiked golf shoes or tennis shoes only.

BALLROOM

1. **Women, Girls, Juniors** – Bermuda shorts and slacks are permitted. Short shorts, halter tops, bare midriffs, athletic wear and tank tops not permitted. Bare feet and stocking feet are not permitted in the Clubhouse. Denim as defined below.
2. **Men, Boys, Juniors** – Slacks and collared shirts. Men's and boys' shirts must be tucked in; Island resort wear & square-cut shirts may be un-tucked. Proper golf attire permitted at golf related events. Men's and boys' hats and visors are to be removed. No athletic wear. Bare feet and stocking feet are not permitted in the clubhouse. Denim as defined below.
3. **Denim Definition** – Denim worn as slacks, cut at waist level, in good repair with no holes, rips, tears, tatters or frays. Consistent in color – no acid washed denim. No baggy or sagging denim. No visible undergarments.
4. **Modification to Dress Policy** – There will be special occasions where more formal attire will be required. Please refer to the club calendar and promotional flyers for the conditions such as "Jackets Required" or "Black Tie Optional"
