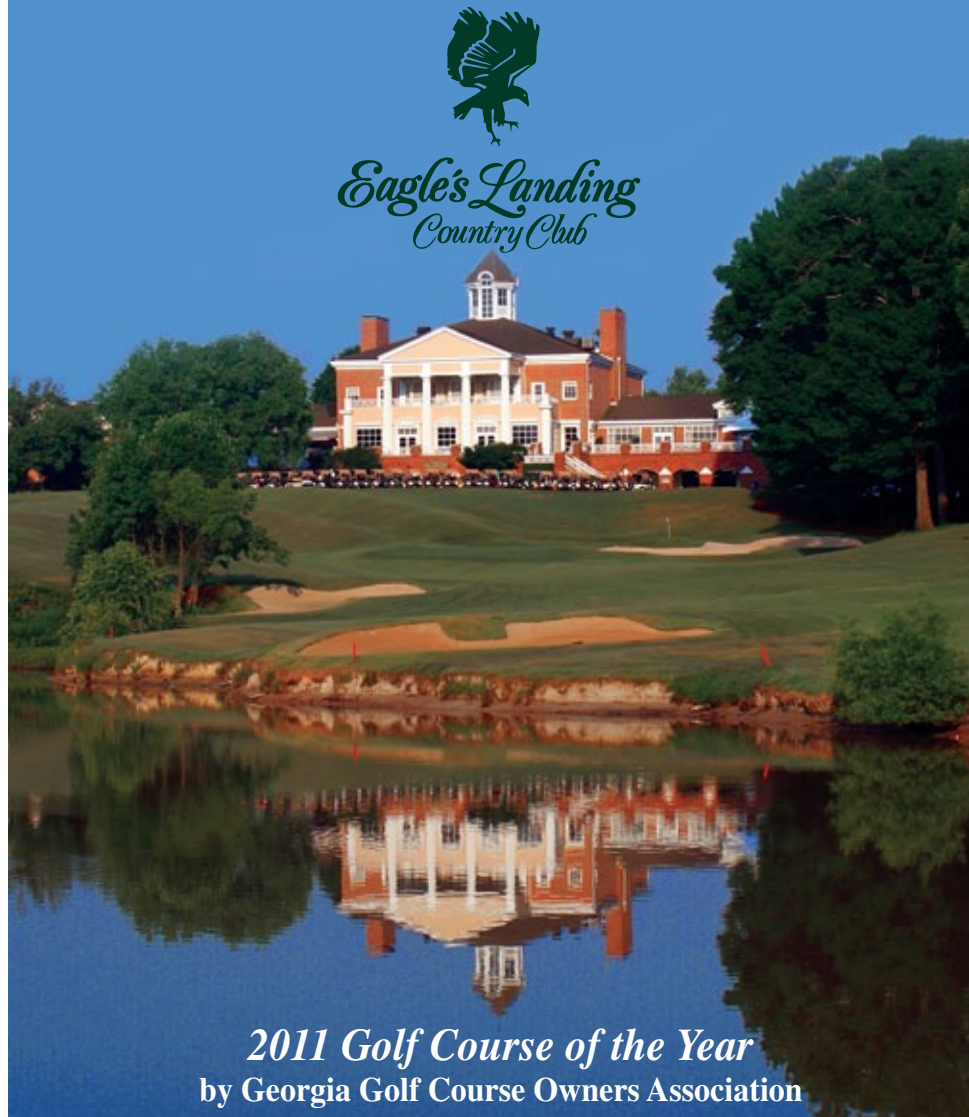
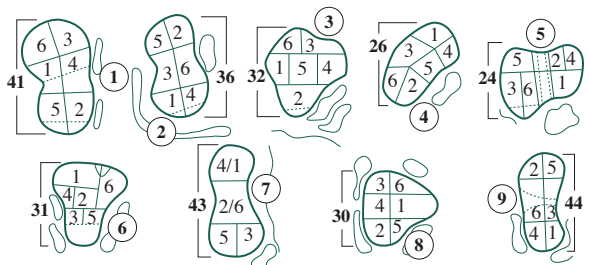

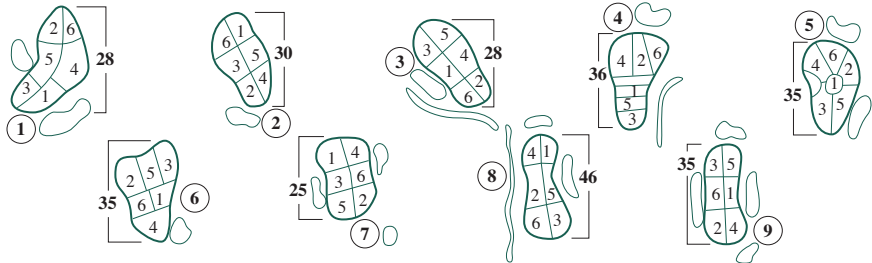

LOCAL RULES

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY AND INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING LOCAL RULES:

- Embedded Ball (Rule 25-2 Appendix I):** "Through the Green"
- Ground Under Repair (Rule 25-1):** Newly sodded areas, irrigation lines and worn areas adjacent to all cart paths are considered ground under repair. Other GUR areas are marked with white paint.
- Temporary Immovable Obstructions (Appendix D):** Relief without penalty is available if the temporary immovable obstruction interferes with your stance, lie of ball, area of swing or if the obstruction interferes between your ball and the hole or if your ball lies within one club length of such interference. Find the nearest point of relief that eliminates interference/intervention as defined above and drop within one club-length, no closer to the hole.
- Out of Bounds:** Defined by white posts and all perimeter roadways in the absence of stakes. Any ball crossing over any street and coming to rest on another part of the course is considered out of bounds.
- Water Hazards: (Rule 26)** Are defined by Yellow Stakes and Yellow lines. The Yellow lines are the true definition of the hazard.
- Lateral Water Hazard: (Rule 26)** Are defined by Red Stakes and Red lines. The Red lines are the true definition of the hazard.
- Mulch Gardens:** "Mulch Gardens" on the course are **NOT** ground under repair, unless otherwise marked. However, the "cut" border (seam) surrounding the exterior of these gardens is considered ground under repair, and relief may be taken under the GUR rule for a ball coming to rest in a "seam" surrounding the mulch gardens, or if a players stance or swing is impeded by the "seam".
- Decorative gardens and bushes:** Decorative gardens and bushes on the course are considered to be "through the green", and no "free" relief is available.
- Please observe cart rule of the day.**
