

# USGA RULES WILL GOVERN ALL PLAY

## BROOKHAVEN COUNTRY CLUB LOCAL RULES:

- Boundaries: White Stakes define out of bounds. In the absence of White Stakes, homeowner's fences and the inside edges of roadway curbing will define Out of Bounds. A Ball crossing any roadway and coming to rest on another part of the course other than the hole being played is deemed to be Out of Bounds.
- The Embedded Ball Rule is in effect through the green (Rule 25-2).
- Through the green, if a ball comes to rest in a weather crack in the earth, it may be dropped with out penalty, as near as possible to the ball's original lie no nearer to the hole (25/12).
- A ball that strikes a power line must be replayed with no penalty as near to the spot as it was originally played from (33-8/13).
- A Ball that comes to rest in any Flower Bed will be given a free drop within on club length nearest point of relief, not nearer to the hole (Rule 33-8a).
- Sprinkler Heads; Relief may be taken if the sprinkler head is within (2) club lengths of the green and your ball is within (2) club lengths of the sprinkler head. The sprinkler head must be in your line of play (Appendix 1, 5d).

## General Information:

- All distances on sprinkler heads are measured to the middle of the green.
- Cart Rules: Please keep all carts on paths when moving toward the green,
- Only 90 degree crossing is permitted.
- PULL CARTS are to be returned to path 30 yards before the green.
- Please properly repair all ball marks, rake all bunkers, replace and sand all divots.
- Bunker rakes should remain immediately outside of the bunker, parallel to the edge of the bunker.
- Please remember all scores should be posted. (This includes 9 hole rounds)
